Northwestern University Resources

BlackBoard also known as Course Management System <http://courses.northwestern.edu>
This system uses your **NetID and password** to log in. Its main focus is **online course activity**. From this site you can turn in assignments, check grades, and reference the syllabus and much more.

This system uses your **NetID and password** to log in. Its main focus is **course enrollment and payment**. From this site you can also search electives, check enrollment, see if you have holds on registration and pay for your tuition bill.
